INTRODUCTION

This training qualifies auditors for 2BSvs certification, allowing auditors to certify according to RED II legislation. Our certification covers the entire chain: from biomass production to raw material collection, through processing and biogas production, and applies to all uses (heat, electricity and transport).

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

At the end of this training, the participant will have an understanding of the legal framework and the impact for an economic operator (legal entity) of holding a valid 2BSvs - Biogas certificate.

They will learn the RED II requirements, the biomethane production process, the audit scope, the certification units, the traceability of key information (country of origin, type of materials, tonnage, sustainability characteristics and legal ownership), and will be able to carry out 2BS audits for operators in the biogas sector.

TRAINING CONTENT

During the training, the auditors will see the legal framework and the impact for an economic operator (legal entity) of holding a valid 2BSvs - Biogas certificate.

They will learn about RED II requirements, the biomethane production process, the audit scope, certification units, traceability of key information (country of origin, type of materials, tonnage, sustainability characteristics and legal ownership), among other important topics.

PREREQUISITES

To participate in the 2BSvs training, the auditor must hold a qualification diploma in product or system certification, combined with sector expertise in the different areas of the fuel supply chain, such as agriculture, agronomy, transport and storage logistics, and fuel processing units. At the end of this training, the participant will have an understanding of the legal framework and the impact for an economic operator (legal entity) of holding a valid 2BSvs – Biofuels or Bioliquids certificate. They will learn the requirements of RED II, the biofuels and bioliquids production process, the audit scope, the certification units, the traceability of key information (country of origin, type of materials, tonnage, sustainability characteristics and legal ownership), and will be able to carry out 2BS audits for operators in the biofuels or bioliquids sector.

TRAINING CONTENT

During the training, auditors will see the legal framework and the impact for an economic operator (legal entity) of holding a valid 2BSvs - Biofuels and Bioliquids certificate. They will learn about the chain of custody, the audit scope, the certification units, the traceability of key information (country of origin, type of materials, tonnage, sustainability characteristics and legal ownership), among other important topics.

TRAINING IN ENGLISH





INTRODUCTION

This training is designed for 2BSvs auditors who have completed the biofuels training, in order to continue their 2BS auditor qualification enabling them to audit « co-processing » fuel production, that integrates both organic and fossil feedstocks in a single process.

LEARNING OBJECTIVES

By the end of this training, participants will have an understanding of the specificities of auditing and certifying biofuel production through co-processing, including:

- Mass balance,
- C14 analysis,
- · Conversion factors,
- GHG calculation.
- Sampling rules.

TRAINING CONTENT

During the training, auditors will explore the relevant regulatory framework for coprocessing and understand the impact for an economic operator of holding a 2BSvs certificate. They will learn about the requirements of RED II and the Delegated Act (EU) 2023/1640 on co-processing, as well as the 2BS-PRO-06 (coprocessing) and the specific audit obligations related to co-processing.

PREREQUISITES

This training is open only to individuals who have completed the biofuels training for 2BS auditors.

METHOD AND TOOLS

Live online training (videoconference), in English.

Presentation and explanation of materials by the 2BS technical team.

Interactive questionnaires, Q&A sessions, and a final exam to assess acquired knowledge.

AUDITORS TO DO'S

To audit for one of 2BS certifications, auditors have obligations before, during and after the training.

Discover below the auditors to-do list not to miss any tasks!

BEFORE THE TRAINING

Before the training, the auditor will be invited to create and complete his personal space on the 2BS platform with the following information:

- Email
- CV
- Certifications/Diplomas

DURING THE TRAINING

The auditor's commitment to the training is fundamental to the success of the session.

AFTER THE TRAINING

At the end of the training, auditors must pass an assessment test within seven days. This exam will be available on the 2BS website, in the auditor's personal space. A result of more than 70% correct answers is required to validate the training. Successful completion of the exam is mandatory for the auditor to be able to certify with 2BSvs.

If the auditor is not qualified directly, he/she can retake the exam. If the auditor is still not qualified, he/she can participate in another training session.

Every 2BSvs auditor must pass an annual review, available in their 2BS personal space. This review covers topics such as regulatory changes and the harmonization of audit approaches (defined based on data from 2BS control reviews).

Additionally, information is often shared with representatives of certification bodies to be passed on to auditors, in order to maintain regular communication.

GENERAL SALES CONDITIONS

MINIMUM OF PARTICIPANTS

- Registration deadline: 40 days before the training
- Please note that at least 5 participants are needed for the training to be confirmed.
- Once the minimum of registered participants is achieved, you will receive an Outlook invitation to block your agenda. The next steps you must accomplish before the training will also be detailed in the invitation. Until you receive the Outlook invitation, the training is not confirmed.
- If the minimum of participants is not achieved one (1) month before the beginning of the session, the training is canceled. The auditor will be informed by email if his/her session is canceled. He/she will be able to register for another session within one year, with no extra costs.

PARTICIPATION CANCELLATION BY THE AUDITOR

 Cancellation of registration up to 31 days before the seminar is free of charge. From 30 to 14 days before the training session, 20% of the costs will be charged. Cancellation up to 13 to 8 days prior to the session date, 50% of costs will be charged. From 7 days prior to the seminar, 100% of the session costs will be charged.
